ORDINANCE NO. 361

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TAX LEVY
FOR SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER 1
IN THE VILLAGE OF PRAIRIE GROVE
FOR THE 2004 TAX YEAR

WHEREAS, the Village of Prairie Grove, McHenry County, Illinois, passed Ordinance Number 273 on June 8, 2000 establishing Special Service Area Number 1 in the Village of Prairie Grove; and

WHEREAS, said ordinance authorized the payment of \$64,011.60 to pay the cost of acquisition of and construction of roads, curbs and gutters, street lights, storm sewers and miscellaneous street improvements within the Special Service Area; and

WHEREAS, said funds are to be retired over a period of 10 years and at an interest rate of 5¼%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Prairie Grove, McHenry County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby levied over all the taxable property within Special Service Area No. 1 in the Village of Prairie Grove the total sum of \$8,443.31 for the 2004 tax year.

Special Service Area Number 1 for the Village of Prairie Grove is legally described as follows:
BARREVILLE HEIGHTS

BEING A SUBDIVISION OF THE NORTH 30 ACRES, EXCEPT THE NORTH 200 FEET THEREOF, OF THE EAST ONE HALF OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 44 NORTH, RANGE 8 EAST OF THE 3rd PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, McHENRY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

EXCLUDING LOT 19 OF SAID BARREVILLE HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION.

SECTION 3: The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file with the McHenry County Clerk a duly certified copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 5: Severability: If any portion of this ordinance is adjudged, or declared by appropriate authority, to be unenforceable or invalid for any reason, the remaining portions of the ordinance not affected by such adjudication shall remain in full force and effect.
